**Population**

Describes a particular group of patients; may include primary problem, disease, or coexisting conditions

Example: Cardiac arrest patients

**Intervention**

Includes main intervention, prognostic factor, or exposure

Example: Who received CPR

**Comparator**

Describes the main alternative

Example: Compared with no CPR

**Outcome**

What is being accomplished, improved, measured

Example:

1. Neurologically intact survival
2. Survival to discharge
3. ROSC
