Convert to AHA ECC Class I (Strong) Recommendation If Benefit >>> Risk Therapy or test is "recommended/indicated, effective/beneficial, should be done." This applies to therapies or tests that are considered the standard of care or that should generally be provided or used for the vast majority of patients. Maybe Convert to AHA ECC Class IIa (Moderate) Recommendation If Benefit >> Risk **GRADE** strong recommendation Therapy or test is "probably recommended, is reasonable, in favor can be useful/effective/beneficial." It is appropriate for most Maybe patients, with some exceptions. Unlikely Convert to AHA ECC Class IIb (Weak) Recommendation If Benefit > Risk Therapy or test "may/might be reasonable or may/might be considered, but other options are acceptable." The "usefulness/effectiveness is unknown/unclear/uncertain or will not well established."

Developing an AHA ECC recommendation that is informed by a GRADE strong recommendation in favor of a therapy or diagnostic or prognostic test.
